If you want to see the entire transcript instead of only what is being said at the time, then under the "<u>Live Transcript</u>" button, click on "<u>View Full Transcript</u>" and the Closed Captioning will appear in a pop-up column to the right. You should be able to see the person's name next to what they are saying (great for groups).
